- <u>Pride Foundation Scholarship</u> (due Jan 6th) --- Pride Foundation provides essential financial resources and community support to LGBTQ+ student leaders across the Northwest.
- Ron Brown Scholarship (due Jan 9th) --- For Black/African-American students who are the most talented and economically-challenged high school seniors who demonstrate a keen interest in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship and global citizenship
- <u>APIA Scholarship</u> (due Jan 12th) -- For students with heritage from Asia or the Pacific Islands from lowincome families. Minimum 2.7 GPA required.
- <u>Governor's Scholarship for Foster Youth</u> (due Jan 31st) -- The Washington State Governors' Scholarship for Foster Youth is a scholarship program that helps young men and women from foster care continue their education and earn a college degree.
