#### **COVID TESTING**

#### **Highline Student and Family Testing**

Highline offers free COVID-19 tests to students, staff and household members. Appointments are encouraged but not required. Walk-ups are welcomed based on capacity.

To maximize the number of tests we can do at each clinic, we ask families to complete the consent form (**English**, **Spanish** or **Vietnamese**) before arriving at the test site. If a student is younger than 18 years old, a parent/guardian will need to complete the form.

All student and family testing clinics are open from 3:00 to 4:30 p.m.

#### **Dress & Appearance**

As the weather gets nicer, we want to ensure the classroom environment remains conducive to learning.

Highline Public Schools and school staff believe that learning best occurs in a positive atmosphere. To that end, we expect all of our students to help create a positive environment. Appearance expectations will be enforced throughout each campus. Appearance that causes disruption of the educational process or presents health or safety issues will not be allowed. Please dress in such a manner so as not to detract or distract from student learning.
