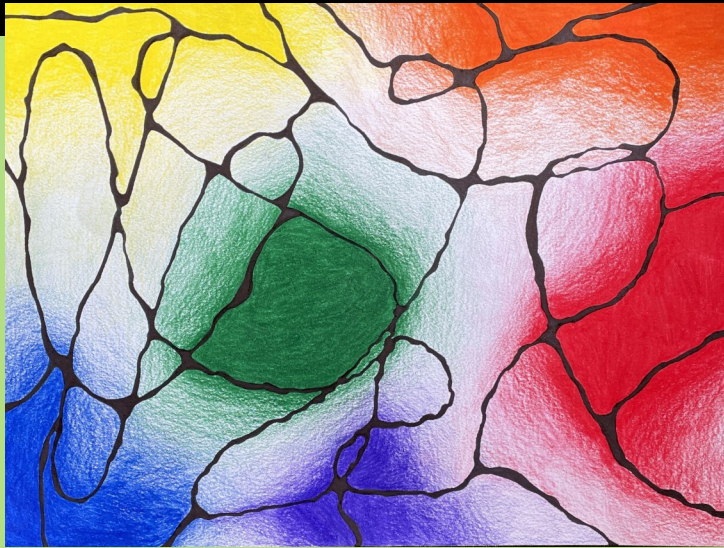
Picture retake day will be on Wednesday, October 6th

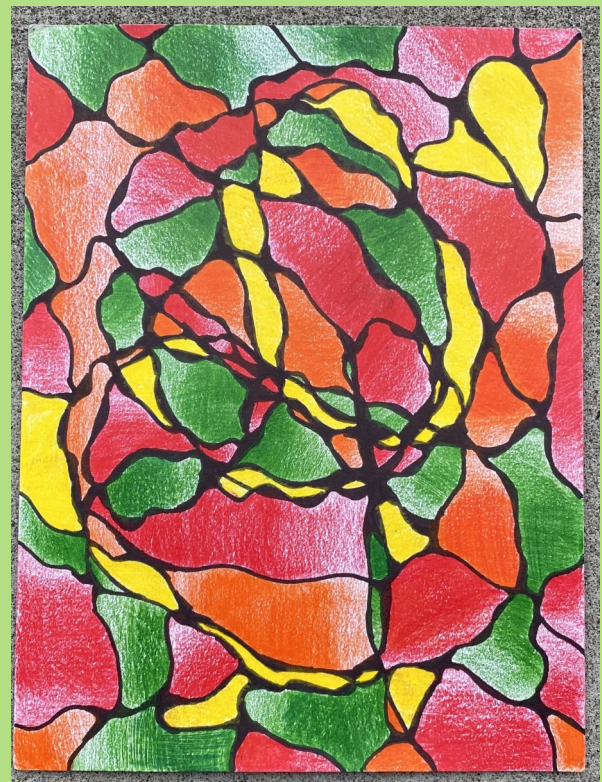

Free COVID testing every week

All Highline staff, students, and family members are welcomed at any of the testing sites listed below. All testing sites will occur **outdoors** unless otherwise communicated. Testing is recommended 5-7 after an individual's last day of close contact to a positive COVID case. Test samples are self-administered, shallow-nasal swabs. COVID tests are lab-based PCR (polymerase chain reaction), the gold standard in accuracy.


