### Dear Tye Students and Families,

Happy Spring Break! We are busily preparing to support all of our students in both remote and on-campus learning when we return, and we are so excited about. Please read below for information and updates regarding the model you and your family have chosen for Quarter Four.

All students, both remote and hybrid, will start both Monday and Thursday with Advisory at 8:30am.\*\* On Tuesday and Friday students will start their day at **8:30am in 1<sup>st</sup> period**. Wednesday will be remote for ALL students.

- Use hand sanitizer entering each classroom

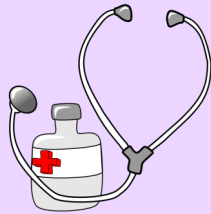
